The CACRC is located in Baton Rouge, Louisiana and operates a 35,000 square foot facility.

The CACRC's Green Community Partners help us with our Computers for Louisiana Families program. We offer refurbished computers for schools, non-profits, and low-income families as needed through our year-round programs. These computers have helped thousands of families and non profits purchase their first computers. Your generous donation of \$2000 gives your company top priority on our schedule for us to pick up your computer equipment. All recycling fees are also waived for our CACRC Green Community Partners. Your company's logo will also be listed on our website. Woman's Hospital of Baton Rouge is one of our very generous Green Community Partners.

The CACRC picks computer equipment up from companies throughout Louisiana. All hard drives are wiped clean whether it is requested or not to the national standards. If hard drives are inoperable they will be physically destroyed. Certificates of Destruction are available upon request for your donation. The following charges apply to your company if you are not a CACRC Green Community Partner: \$7 per CRT and \$3 per printer. Mileage fees also apply depending on where your company is located.

The CACRC accepts the following equipment donations: Computers, monitors, printers, speakers, power cords, keyboards, mice, VGA cables, other cords/cables, VHS players, DVD players, stereo equipment, CD players, phone systems, cell phones, video game systems (Xbox, Playstation, etc.) and anything with a circuit board.
